

'Follow'

Pilgrim is a major new teaching and discipleship resource from the Church of England.

It aims to help every local church create a place where people can explore the Christian faith together and see how it can be lived out each day.

Pilgrim takes a different approach to other Christian programmes.

It approaches the great issues of faith not through persuasion, but by participation in a pattern of contemplation and discussion with a group of fellow travellers.

Pilgrim has two stages

The 'Follow' stage for those very new to faith, and the 'Grow' stage for those who want to go further.

Each stage contains four short six-session courses which focus on a major theme of Christian life.
