

How can we help people in our community to pray during this health crisis? How can we still help people connect with each other and with God if we can't offer physical spaces for this happen?

Coronaprayers Ryedale is an online platform for people in our community where you can light a candle for someone else, find some inspiration or send in prayer requests. It is accessible for everyone including people who don't consider themselves religious.

The focus is to facilitate prayer for whatever concerns people. People pray for family members, frontline services, people who are unwell as well as things that aren't covid 19 related.

The website is also accessible from smartphones. In the evenings there are interactive livestream prayers on the YouTube channel of Coronaprayers. During the interactive livestream prayers we pray for the prayer requests received and the prayer requests people might feed in during the livestream.
